Workshops

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1. What are this year's EUSTORY Youth Activities about?

Let's connect and act across borders! To do so, you can choose between 3 digital, international workshops taking place on a weekly basis in October: Apply for a simulation game on transitional justice, a diversity training or a European HomeParliament! To breathe some international spirit in advance to the workshops already, you can join our 2 informal and fun community events in August and September. Find more info [here](#).

2. Who can apply for EUSTORY Youth Activities?

The digital programme "Let's ConnAct! Bonding Across Borders" is organised by EUSTORY and Körber-Stiftung in an alliance with partners. Prize winners and alumni from national history competitions of the EUSTORY Network are warmly invited to apply. But there will also be space for young people aged 16 to 26 from partner networks as well as anyone enthusiastic for international exchange on history and identity in Europe and beyond.

3. When do this year's EUSTORY Youth Activities take place?

This year's EUSTORY Youth Activities take place on a weekly basis in October 2022, predominantly in the late afternoons and/or on Saturdays. To connect with peers from all over Europe even before, you can also participate in the informal Community Events in August and September 2022 already.

4. Where do this year's EUSTORY Youth Activities take place?

This year's EUSTORY Youth Activities will be held online. However, there is one exception: In the framework of the European HomeParliaments (Workshop No. 1) you have the choice between hosting a physical meeting and discuss the topic in a local surrounding, or do it digitally and debate with peers from different countries online.

5. How can I apply?

Please fill in the [application form](#). For organisational reasons, there will be several subsequent application deadlines. Apply now, as applications will be considered on a "first come, first serve" basis. In case of free capacities, late applications will be accepted until 22 September 2022. 6. Can I apply for more than one workshop?

Yes, applying for more than one workshop is possible. When filling in the [application form](#) online, you will be able to give preferences and select the workshop of your first, second and third choice.

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7. Can I participate in more than one workshop?

As the three workshops overlap in time, participation in more than one digital workshop is not possible.

8. What do I need to participate?

You will need internet access and a computer, tablet or mobile phone (a bigger screen than a phone is recommended). Please make sure you have access to a proper webcam and microphone so you can communicate well with your workshop group.

Profound English skills are absolutely necessary for participation.

9. Is there a minimum or maximum age for participation?

EUSTORY Youth Activities are open to participants aged 16 to 26 years. If you miss this age-range slightly, please contact eustory@korber-stiftung.de.

10. Is there anything I need to consider if I am under 18 years old?

Yes. Workshop applicants born after 18 August 2004 need to hand in a Declaration of Consent signed by legal guardians. Please find the document [here](#).

11. What happens if I confirmed my participation in a workshop, but I am not able to participate?

Once confirmed for a workshop, your participation is binding and your attendance is obligatory. A later cancellation will only be possible under certain circumstances (cf. "[Terms and Conditions](#)").

12. How much time does participation in a digital workshop require?

We designed the workshops in a way they can be integrated into your daily school, university or working routine, meaning the sessions will take place once or twice a week, predominantly in the late afternoons and/or on Saturdays. As we have to cope with different time zones, we are asking all participants to be as flexible as possible when the time slots for joint video sessions will be determined. You should expect a workload of 3-4 hours per week for the entire duration of your workshop.

13. How does online collaboration with my workshop group work?

Interactive collaboration with your workshop group, as well as regular information supply will take place in a private virtual classroom on the EUSTORY History Campus platform. Details for registration will follow via e-mail together with your successful application.

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14. Will there be opportunities to get to know participants from other workshops?

Yes! In our Community Events taking place in August and September, you have the chance to meet even more peers from abroad in an informal and fun setting.

15. What is a Community Event? Do I need to apply for it?

A Community Event is a single activity in which you can use the advantages of the digital world to easily have fun with peers from all over Europe and beyond in an intercultural get-together. If you want to participate in one or several community events, please register here.

16. How much time does participation in a Community Event require?

Both Community Events are a short evening-format, meaning they will last approx. 60 to 90 minutes each.

17. Will there be any costs?

Participation in all EUSTORY Youth Activities is free of charge.
