General Remarks

Before applying for one of the digital activities, please ensure that you will indeed be able to participate. The activity you apply for might interfere with school, university or work schedules. If it does and you require assistance to obtain leave from school or university due to special reasons (e.g. an exam), please contact the EUSTORY Team (eustory@koerber-stiftung.de) to issue a request to the principal of your school or university.

Participation of Minors

The digital programme "Let's ConnAct! Bonding Across Borders" will be open for minors. When applying as a person younger than 18 years, you have to include a Declaration of Consent signed by the legal guardians.

No Legal Right to Participation

Unfortunately, it will not always be possible to enable all applicants to participate. There is no legal right to participation. Even after an invitation has been issued, the digital activity you applied for may have to be cancelled due to illness of staff or a force majeure. As the number of participants is restricted in all activities, it is not always possible to offer you the workshop of your first choice.

Withdrawal from Participation

Pedagogical projects like this year's EUSTORY Youth Activities are expensive and costs arise even when a participant withdraws. Therefore, the following rule applies: After having received an invitation to a digital workshop, the candidate can reject to participate within one week.

Participants who disturb the workshop or disregard the given instructions may be excluded from participation.

Use of Material

Photos, audio recordings or videos taken of and/or by the participants during the activity may be used for publication in all media e.g. on the internet, in video-clips and print media by the organisers (Körper-Stiftung, EUSTORY) or by their project partners (Pulse of Europe). Moreover, the participants agree to the publication of their work results for documentation purposes in print media, on radio, television, online or in the frameworks of public events hosted by the organisers or their project partners.
